Registration season 2023-2024

Despite the many price increases, thanks to our sponsors and event partners, we have managed not to increase the registration fee.

Last season the number of participating teams grew by 20% and we expect this increase to continue.

This means we will be hosting eight League Meets. Four in Round 1 (November/December) and four in Round 2 (January/February). Like last season, your team participates once in Round 1 and once in Round 2. All teams that have registered will be automatically notified to pass on League Meet preferences. At this time, the dates and locations are not yet known.

From various sides, volunteers and teams, we have received information that the Benelux Championship is a very busy day and there is hardly any time to relax. We will not drastically change the setup of the day, but we will reduce the number of participating teams from 28 to 24. This means that the 24 highest ranked teams may participate in the Benelux Championship that will take place on February 24th at Avans University of Applied Sciences in Breda.

An extra incentive to get the best out of your team to secure one of the coveted spots in the Championship!

Implementation of FTC in the curriculum

We have announced it several times. Starting next season, the first step will be taken for the implementation of FTC in the curriculum. We will start with vmbo education. The learning modules that are currently being developed by WisMon educational institute are aligned with the elective subjects Robotics and Innovation & Prototyping and aimed at classroom implementation or as an extracurricular activity. The learning modules are all in Dutch and will become part of a so-called Classpack.

In September 2023 we will have the full Classpacks ready. The final price of the Classpack has yet to be determined, but to early adopters of the 2023-2024 season we would like to present an introductory offer. For an amount of €1395,00 your school can benefit from our special Classpack for vmbo. This package includes the following components:

• An annual license for the comprehensive Dutch teaching materials, which can be accessed through the Leapo learning portal of WisMon.

- FTC season registration fee, including participation of one team in the competition and free access to almost all activities organized by FTC Benelux.
- A half-day FTC coaching training for one person, to ensure that coaches are well prepared for competition.
 You will get content on FTC, how to prepare as a coach, what is expected of you and the team, useful resources and many more tools to get started and become successful with your students.
- A half-day FTC didactic training for one person, specifically focused on implementing FTC into the vmbo curriculum. You will learn how to create a powerful Robotics and/or Innovation & Prototyping curriculum based on the FIRST Tech Challenge. You will be explained the different possible routes you can follow using the learning modules and receive tips and tricks about the competition.

The Classpack can be optionally extended with:

- Didactic training for additional person/persons
- FTC coach training for additional person/persons
- Robot education hardware kit (REV Robotics)
- FTC Mini Game tailored to seasonal assignment (AndyMark)
- Additional education hardware kit(s)
